

INTERNATIONAL GIRLS CLUB WEEK

Each year during the week of Valentine's Day, we celebrate International Girls Clubs Week. This is a special time to recognize the efforts and dedication of our Girls Clubs, members, counselors and prayer mothers, and to advertise to local communities the ministry available to them through Girls Clubs.

A program is written for the celebration each year, in conjunction with the Department of Women's Ministries World Missions project. For the first year—the year following the General Assembly—the program will be written specifically about the country or location selected. It will also include information about the missions project. Subsequently, the program will be written about the Church of God and what we are doing in the selected country.

Voluntary offerings are received during the International Girls Clubs Week for Girls On A Mission or Translation of Girls Clubs material. The local churches should send their offerings to the state office and these monies will be sent to the Women's Ministries Department.
